Under the supervision of RS Bisht. It was excavated successfully by 2005.

Ahmedabad became the first city of India to be registered its name in UNESCO list in 2017.

Ahmedabad is well known as the Manchester city of India.





VEDIC MATHEMATICS

Written by the Indian monk Bharti Krishna Tirtha is a book of Vedic mathematics that was published in 1965. It contains many mathematical techniques which were claimed to have been retrieved from the Vedas and contained in mathematical knowledge. This book contains metaphorical aphorism in the form of 16 sutras and 13 sub sutras which Krishna tirtha states allude to significant mathematical tools.

Some Vedic mathematic tricks :

Finding the square of a 2-digit number that ends with 5. Let's take the example of $(25)^2$.

Step 1: $25 \times 25 = \underline{\quad}25$ (the answer will always end with 25)

Step 2: multiply the first digit of the two-digit number by (the first digit +1)to find the term for the blank . $2 \times (2+1) = 6$

Therefore the answer to $(25)^2 = 625$

Multiplying any number by 5

Let's take the example of $2244 \times 5 = ?$

Step 1: divide the number by 2.this will make $2244/2 = 1122$

Step 2: add a zero to the calculation above and you will get the answer :11220
